

Code of Conduct for Participants:

Participants are requested to adhere to the following:

- Every participant is required to carry his or her college identity (ID) card on campus. They are requested to keep their registration band with them at all times.
- Be polite and respectful towards staff (teaching, non-teaching, and administrative), organizers, and fellow participants.
- Follow the timing as specified in the schedule. Plan to arrive at the venue on time to avoid any hassle. It is mandatory for all the participants to stay on campus for the entire duration of the event.
- Participants are expected to read and follow notices and updates posted on the Discord channel from time to time.
- Participants must help to keep the campus neat and clean. Do not scribble on the desks, the bulletin boards, or the walls or trees of the college. Spitting, smoking, and throwing bits of paper on the premises are prohibited.
- Misuse or unauthorised use of the institute premises or items will lead to disciplinary and penal action.
- Ragging is strictly prohibited on the campus. Any incident of ragging will be dealt with serious disciplinary action.
- All vehicles should be parked in the allotted place.
- The institute management is not responsible for the safety (including damage to and/or theft or loss of vehicles) of vehicles on the premises.
- Participants must ride or drive their vehicles into and around the campus at a moderate speed; overspeeding will be treated as an act of indiscipline and will attract adverse consequences.
- It is strictly forbidden to smoke or consume alcohol on the institute grounds, or to enter the institute grounds after having consumed alcoholic beverages.
- Participants are required to stay within the bounds of the allotted premises at all times. The volunteers will assist them if they have any needs.
- Participants shall do nothing, either inside or outside the institute, that will in any way interfere with its orderly conduct and discipline.
- The Institute is not responsible for lost property.
- Participants are bound by the rules and regulations of the institute.
